
Popley Matters



So, what is this place called Popley?

In the days, when the northern outpost of Basingstoke was a few streets behind the railway station, way out towards Sherborne St John was an area known as Popley Fields.

Much later on, the then London County Council and the local Council got together to build large housing estates and one of the sites chosen was Popley Fields.

Contracts were awarded to large building firms, who moved in and got on with the job of building houses to specific contracts. As more than one contractor was involved, delivery of building materials became a problem, and so the contractors numbered the estates for ease of delivery. Signs went up, Popley 1 and Popley 4 etc., and as people moved into these areas, this is what the estate became known as.

About fifteen years ago the local council decided that the areas should not be known by numbers but that they should be given names instead.

So Popley came under review and the following names were decided upon.

Popley 1 became Popley Walk, Popley 2 and 3 became Popley Islands, Popley 4 became Popley Abbey.

With the development of Popley 5, this area became Popley Everest.

Popley 6, being Trinidad Close and Tobago Close, became Popley Dell.







The group is trained by Alison Williamson, also from Popley, and Daniel Dawes, both National and International and European Champions themselves, who give their time voluntarily.


