

## REPORT OF GAZETTE MEETING

At the end of last year, three members of the Forum committee (Editor Jane Frankum; Liaison Officer Kate Lomas; Secretary Mike Birch) met with Bill Brown of the Basingstoke Gazette to discuss raising the profile of Popley in the newspaper which it was felt has hitherto concentrated too heavily upon the few negative aspects which can haunt any estate.

The meeting lasted for nearly one and a half hours during which time many matters were raised and discussed with particular emphasis upon the positive role of the youth groups in the area with many young people keen to take an active part in building a better society for the future.

The Forum told Bill of how the majority of residents want to live in a friendly, go-ahead area where conversation is always preferred to confrontation. Basingstoke is trying to gain a reputation as an innovative town and Popley could help lead the way for this to happen.

Bill said he was impressed with the discussion and with the work of the Forum and said how he would do his best for the Gazette to help in projecting the positive side of life in Popley, which represents the majority of residents.



## The Basingstoke Karate/Kickboxing Organisation

The Basingstoke Karate/Kickboxing organisation has been in existence for eleven years, teaching both adults and children.

The kickboxing side of B.K.K.O. dedicates itself to competition training and competes at regional, national and international level.

The club has bred champions in all of these categories. Most notable is Mel Cummings who began training as a child and is now the Ladies British Champion. Mel also gained a forth place in last years European championships. Many of our younger students are encouraged to take part in competitions as we feel that this builds character, a sense of discipline and achievement.

B.K.K.O.'s Chief instructor Ron Peplow began training in Karate in 1975 he holds a third dan in Wado Ryu karate and a second dan at Kickboxing. Ron has competed regularly in tournaments throughout his career, his last result being a silver medal in the W.A.K.O. British championships in 1997.

B.K.K.O. has now opened a new club at Melrose Hall 6-00-7-30pm on Monday nights for children aged sixteen and under. Training consists of fitness, bagwork and sparring but above all fun. 
### BOYS BRIGADE HIGH ACHIEVER AWARD.
