

Councillors' Page: There is a very helpful website if you have problems with street lighting you can pinpoint the light and report any faults on line. http://www.lightsoninhampshire.co.uk/Public/Default.aspx.lt has every light on every street in Hampshire and the number on the lamppost to use. There are a number of paths in Popley that are being repaired or resurfaced at present, it may be inconvenient for a while with some of them being closed off in sections, but they really do need to be done. Most paths are Hampshire County Councils responsibility but some paths may belong to the housing association or even not yet adopted especially in the newer developments.

Merton Schools expansion is proceeding well, and the liaison group made up of staff, residents, builders, Hampshire County Council Officers and Popley West councillors will meet again next week to discuss any issues. The expansion of Marnel Schools in Popley east will be progressing soon too. I know the staff and children are looking forward to some new facilities that will be in the new buildings.

Cllr Paul Frankum and I had a meeting with Basingstoke and County officers to discuss the next phase, the responses from the residents and the possible options of the yellow lines proposal in Marnel Park. You can read the statement we requested from the officers on page 11. The options will go for the decision by Basingstoke and Deane Executive Members of the cabinet. We will of course report back the outcome in the next issue of Popley Matters after it has gone to the cabinet meeting. *Cllr Jane Frankum 01256 819924*

Popley West: The Local Infrastructure Fund will go before Cabinet this month. Your Popley Councillors have supported bids by Popley Fields Community Centre, Melrose Hall and the community group in St Gabriel's Church all for improvements for facilities in Popley. During the next phase we will be supporting funds for Bermuda Hall and for a community room for Chineham House.

We attended and spoke at the licence review called by the police for The Popinjay pub. There had been so many problems in recent years in the past. It used to cater more for the community. We wanted the brewery managers to put in an experienced landlord and start to bring it back as a community facility. We certainly would not like to see it demolished or turned into flats, it is the last public house in Popley. There are a lot of conditions and they have new management and they want to return it to a family friendly place. We will be keeping an eye on it.

With the expectation of worsening winter weather we have asked that all salt bins are filled, but would ask that you respect that it is for public highways to enable residents to be able to get to work, shops or vital appointments. Please don't use cat litter as it holds the water and refreezes like black ice. It can also rot your carpets when you walk back indoors.

Because the Spotlight Centre is not available we have agreed that the replacement polling station will be St Gabriel's Church in Tewksbury Road. Albeit this will obviously not be ideal for some of those voters who have most recently used the Spotlight Centre. We are grateful to the Church for its support on this matter. The only other alternative was a school and we would not like to see the school close for a day. We encourage the use of Postal Votes for electors and details about the way postal votes can be obtained will be advertised shortly. We are happy to assist with this as your local Councillors. Clearly locating polling stations that are conveniently sited for all voters in any ward is difficult.

Please look out for the activities being organised at the Popley Fields Community Centre encouraging people to get involved with cycling. Through to March there are guided family bike rides and bike maintenance sessions there, together with free bike check- ups and basic repairs. These are likely to be popular and can be booked on www. myjourneyhampshire.com/basingstokecycle.

We expect to see work starting on Chineham House shortly bringing it back into use, and included in this work will be the provision of a small community facility with access for those with disabilities.

Autumn Visit to Minsk

I knew before I arranged this visit that I would not be able to stay with the usual family for my whole stay. This was due to their friends from the Gomel Region of Belarus needing to stay in Minsk for hospital appointments.

Ella, who I met in 1995, found a small, cheap hotel for the remainder of this trip. However, as is typical of Belarus, everything changed!

The week before I was due to depart I received a frantic email from Ella telling me the hotel was now closing for redecoration!

Lena, an associate professor of English from the Belarusian State University, emailed me say everything's OK, a retired Russian businessman of her acquaintance, had offered to let me stay with his family. His 14 year old son spoke reasonably good English.

On the first Monday of my stay in the palatial flat of the retired businessman I was at the Linguistic University seeing some students when another frantic 'phone call from Lena informing me some relatives from Russia will be arriving so I can only stay in this flat for one week!

Luckily, Olga, who I'd only met that morning, with her students, immediately said: "Don't worry you can stay with me!"

Olga's husband died two years ago and she has two sons, one of whom is married, and her younger son, Nazar, lives at home as he's 16 years old and still at school. Nazar is a keen basketball player and is about 7 feet tall!

Olga had to go on an educational course for 2 days and as she left she told me: "Make sure Nazar behaves himself!" Why she thought a strapping 16 year old would take any notice of me is beyond me! Surprisingly, he made sure we had plenty to eat and insisted on making me a cup of tea when I came in late!

Both Olga and Nazar want me to stay with them on my next visit.

The warmth and generosity of the people of Belarus, who struggle to make ends meet, never ceases to amaze me!

As usual I was invited to speak to hundreds of students at 5 universities, some of whom I saw at least twice!

Two events made my amusing and entertaining the students worthwhile; in one lesson a very

attractive blonde student sat in front of me just smiling for the whole lesson. When I saw the same group for the second time she didn't stop talking! She explained I'd given her the confidence to speak English!

A different student from a different group managed to say a few words and wanted her photograph taken with me as I'd 'inspired' her to speak English! *Terry Jones Abbey Road*



Dear Friends

As I write, I have just returned from St Gabriel's and a packed and enjoyable Family Communion service. It was great to welcome Gareth from the Christian organisation CAP-Christians Against Poverty - as our guest speaker. He spoke from Matthew's gospel chapter 25 "For I was hungry and you gave me something to eat, I was thirsty and you gave me something to drink, I was a stranger and you invited me in, I needed clothes and you clothed me, I was ill and you looked after me, I was in prison and you came to visit me."

Gareth spoke with passion of their organisation's desire to help those trapped by debt and poverty; something in our culture that is so easy to get caught up in. Time to Consider Your Lasting Power of Attorney By Michael Le Fort, Head of Wills & Probate

Amongst the various pressures that all of us are under considering our plans for the future; we increasingly have to think about our mental capacity and how this might change. 850,000 approximately will be affected by dementia this year alone. It is estimated that by 2025 the figure will be closer to 1 million and that it will continue to rise. 1 in 6 people over the age of 80 suffer from dementia and there are 40,000 people under the age of 65 with dementia.

Dementia is just one example of why it is so important to consider arranging Lasting Powers of Attorney (LPA). These legal documents allow you to appoint an Attorney, often your spouse, partner or perhaps one or more of your children, to make certain decisions on your behalf if you no longer can.

There are two types of LPA. The Property and Affairs LPA allows your Attorney to deal with your finances, dealing with paying your bills, collecting any income and benefits that you might be entitled to and possibly selling you home should the need arise. The Health and Welfare LPA allows your Attorney to make decisions about where you might live and your day to day care but they would not be able to do so until you had lost mental capacity.

This may all seem a long way off, you may think that it does not apply to you. The reality is that it is better to plan ahead because once you have lost mental capacity the time for you to make these decisions for yourself will have passed. Like many matters it is lifetime planning that can be most important and an LPA this is no different. If you wish to be the architect of what should happen to

you if you were to lose mental capacity then it is important to make plans now. Should you fail to do so your family or friends would have to apply to the Court of Protection to become your Deputy (a Court appointed Attorney); a more time consuming and costly process that applying for an LPA.
